

14	WHEREAS, The Homer Harbor facility is primarily illuminated using 150' high mast
15	light poles with 1000w high-pressure sodium lights; and
16	
17	WHEREAS, The light fixtures in the high mast lights are nearly 30 years old, are
18	showing wear and tear, and energy costs are expensive; and
19	
20	WHEREAS, Port and Harbor staff has sought the expertise of Puffin Electric, has
21	researched and tested new LED lights, and has determined the new LED lights will provide
22	glare reduction, may be directed, and will result in lower operation and maintenance costs;
23	and

25	<u>WHEREAS, Research concluded that Apack lights are the very best light</u>
26	replacement for the high mast light poles and a sole source contract with Puffin Electric
27	<u>is required as they are the only Apeck distributor in the state of Alaska; and</u>
28	
29	WHEREAS, Port and Harbor is requesting \$30,000 to purchase twelve new LED lights
30	for the high mast light pole #7, with plans to upgrade the other six high mast lights around the
31	Port and Harbor facility at a later date.
