

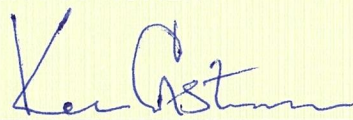
WHEREAS, prohibiting commercial salmon fishing in the federal waters of Cook Inlet effectively eliminates the economic viability of the fishery and viability of local seafood processors; and

WHEREAS, The Homer City Council recognizes that the commercial salmon drift gillnet fleet, like other fisheries users, is a critical component of Homer, positively contributing to the City's local history, culture, and economy.

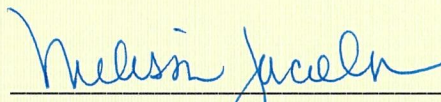
NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of Homer, Alaska, hereby directs the City Attorney to file an amicus brief in the United Cook Inlet Drift Association v National Marine Fisheries Service and National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration, et al., 3:21-cv-00255-JMK litigation.
