Meeting Notes

November, 13, 2012

Cowles Council Chambers

The *purpose* of the meeting was to discuss the progress of the Baycrest Hill Overlook Interpretive Plan. The following is a synopsis of the discussion:

- Some things were repeated or elaborated on from previous meetings such as the number of benches to be recommended (currently there are nine), trash by the toilets, new types of toilets, and perhaps recommending more viewing scopes.
- Decided that a standard-sized “Type D” interpretive panel is appropriate for the site due to its low-profile look and relatively easy maintenance.
- Some additional funding provided by ADF&G will allow for one day of work for a landscape architect to draw an existing site plan and assist with putting recommendations on the site plan for the purposes of the Interpretive Plan.

The *following meeting* scheduled for December 11, 2012 will discuss the following:

- Number and placement of interpretive panels to recommend for the site
- Type of interpretive art to be recommended to replace the wooden carving of Kachemak Bay
- Number and type of services to recommend such as restrooms, benches, tables, and trash cans
