Make a paper list of family contact info for each family member to carry:

- Family phone numbers
- Social media
- Family doctors & medical providers
- Daycare and/or schools.

Sign all household members up for emergency alerts at alerts.kpb.us/.

Agree on safe, familiar places your family will go for protection or to reunite:

- Pick one location in your neighborhood
- Pick one outside your neighborhood like a shelter, friend's house, or place of worship.

Agree on one friend or relative outside the disaster zone every family member will contact:

- Keep this person's number in your wallet and your phone as an ICE (in Case of Emergency) contact.
- Text first, talk second
- If cell lines are down, use land line phones.
