On behalf of the TsunamiReady Advisory Board, I would like to congratulate you on Homer's TsunamiReady recognition. Homer's current StormReady recognition is valid for four years. The recognition will expire on February 22, 2026. I recommend Homer apply for renewed recognition at least six months prior to that date.

As a TsunamiReady community, Homer is authorized to use the TsunamiReady logo in official letterheads, brochures, or other suitable documents. You can find a digital copy of this logo attached to the email with your signed application. If you use the logo in any way, please send the National Weather Service a copy or description of how it was used. The TsunamiReady Community logo is trademarked and subject to certain restrictions, which require the National Weather Service to monitor its use.

You are also authorized to purchase additional TsunamiReady Community signs if you choose. Signs can be purchased for about \$40 each from Oklahoma Correctional Industries by calling 405-962-7007.

Finally, if Homer participates in the National Flood Insurance Program, it is eligible for additional ISO community rating system points. I recommend the TsunamiReady Community information be supplied to appropriate officials during the next ISO rating, if appropriate.
