





Q2 What INDOOR Parks, Art, Cultural and Recreation activities do you currently participate in in Homer? (Check all that apply)









Q3 What desired INDOOR Parks, Art, Cultural and Recreation activities would you like to do more of, or in addition to what you currently do? (Check all that apply)








Q6 What is your motivation for participating in these PARC activities? (check all that apply)

Q7 How well do Homer's facilities and services meet the needs of your household?



Q8 What INDOOR facilities did your household use? (pre-pandemic?)




Q10 How important are the availability of accessible arts activities to you and your immediate family/friends?

Q11 How often would you like to participate in art or recreation activities after the pandemic?



Q12 What prevents you from RECREATING more/more often? (check all that apply)




Q13 What prevents you from participating in ARTS ACTIVITIES more/more often? (check all that apply)










Q17 Of the acceptable funding sources, which do you prefer?










Q20 One method to leverage funding is to partner with private businesses. Do you own or manage a business that would pay to use/lease/rent space?


Q26 When you travel to events outside the Homer area do you: (check all that apply)


Q27 Thinking about tourism: Are there events you attend elsewhere that you would like to see happen in Homer?




Q29 Do you have anyone under 18 currently living in your home?



Q31 What is your gender?







Q12 How important are the availability of recreation activities to you and your immediate family/friends?




