## **Team Fee:**

In general, rough play will not be tolerated and we expect the officials to call games according to the National Federation Rules as we expect the players to show good sportsmanship and fair play at all times. Play to your best ability and let everyone have a good time. \*Remember: games are held on school district property. Use of alcohol or drugs is prohibited and will result an immediate ejection for the rest of the season. PLEASE SUPERVISE OR HAVE SUPERVISION FOR ALL CHILDREN. Kids should not be playing in the halls or left unattended as this is a huge liability for the recreation program.

In addition to the National Federation rules HCRABL has the following rules:

- 1. Length of game: Two twenty minute (20) halves running time, stop on all fouls until the ball is handed to the shooter for the last/ $2^{nd}$  shot, regular stop time the last 3 minutes for the  $1^{st}$  and  $2^{nd}$  half.
- 2. 5 timeouts per game: 3 long and 2 short.
- 3. Fighting where fists are thrown is automatic ejection from the game and league for the remainder of the season.
- 4. Games are forfeited if a team is not ready to play 5 minutes after the scheduled game time or if the second or third game of the evening, 15 minutes after the end of the preceding game.
- 5. Each team must have at least four (4) players to play. Less than four players is a forfeit.
- 6. No current high school students on any teams.
- 7. Any new player can join any team providing that they pay the \$65 participation fee and did not play on a different team with the exception of approval between the two team captains. Transferred player must be able to play 4 regular season games with new team to play in playoffs.
- 8. All players must play at least four regular season games prior to the playoffs and championship games.
- 9. All participants must sign code of conduct and registration forms and pay the <u>\$65</u> participation fee prior to playing the first game.

Misc. Policies

- 1. The HCRABL Executive Board will be the team captains, a representative from the Officials association and Mike Illg, HCR Manager. They will have the responsibility of acting on matters concerning the League and games.
- 2. The HCRABL is scheduled and coordinated through the Homer Community Recreation and is subjected to its rules and policies.
