As part of the American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA), the City of Homer was awarded \$1,433,370.33 to be paid in two tranches across two different years. The first tranche was received in FY22 and appropriated as revenue replacement. The second tranche was originally considered for use for water and sewer needs. That approach did not work as planned so we are asking Council to use Ordinance 23-42 to re-appropriate the second tranche of ARPA funds to the General Fund as revenue replacement. Our ability to accept ARPA funds as revenue replacement was confirmed by an analysis conducted by Porter & Alison before we appropriated the original tranche in 2022.
