Homer City Code 1.74.040 Duties and responsibilities of Commission, is 16 17 amended to read as follows: 18 19 1.74.040 Duties and responsibilities of Commission, a. It shall be the duty of the Commission to act in an advisory capacity to the City Manager and the City Council on the 20 21 problems and development of parks and recreation facilities within the service area. Considerations of the Commission may include existing facilities, possible future development 22 23 and recommendations on land use. b. Any recommendation the Commission may have regarding park and recreation 24 facilities and public beaches is to be directed to the City Council through the City Manager or the 25 recommendations of the Commission concerning policy issues shall be sent directly to the 26 Council upon request of the Commission. 27 c. The Commission shall consider any specific proposal, problem or project as directed 28 by the City Council and any report or recommendations thereon shall be made directly to the 29 Council, unless otherwise directed by the Council. 30 31 d. The Commission may solicit donations of money and property for the benefit of parks and recreation facilities in the City. Any money donations shall be deposited to the City Treasury 32 in a reserve fund designated for parks and recreation facility use. If property, it shall be accepted 33 by deed or other conveyance subject to approval by the City Council. Such property shall be held 34 or disposed of for public parks and recreation purposes as the Council may direct. The 35 Commission may make recommendations for disposition of money or property so received and 36 such recommendations shall be considered and acted upon by the Council. 37 38 e. The City Council may at a future date expand or withdraw duties and responsibilities of the Commission. 39 40 Section 2. Section 1 of this Ordinance is of a permanent and general character and shall 41 42 be included in the City Code.
