1 CITY OF HOMER 2 HOMER, ALASKA 3 City Manager/Public Works Director 4 5 **ORDINANCE 11-35** 6 AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF HOMER, ALASKA, 7 8 AMENDING THE FY 2011 **OPERATING** BUDGET 9 APPROPRIATING \$24,510.24 FROM THE PUBLIC WORKS DEPRECIATION RESERVES FOR THE ACQUISITION OF NEW 10 11 "NARROW BAND" RADIOS FOR THE PUBLIC DEPARTMENT IN ORDER TO MEET FCC REQUIREMENTS AND 12 13 IMPROVE PUBLIC SAFETY AND EMERGENCY RESPONSE. 14 15 WHEREAS, The Federal Communications Commission (FCC) has mandated that all two way radios be operated on "narrow band" frequencies by January 1, 2013 and that radios not narrow band 16 capable must be taken out of service at that time; and 17 18 19 WHEREAS, The Kenai Peninsula Borough, Office of Emergency Management, has been undertaking a borough-wide project to upgrade all two way radios at public safety departments in order to 20 21 meet the FCC mandate; and 22 23 Public safety departments within the Borough, including the Homer Police WHEREAS, 24 Department and the Homer Volunteer Fire Department, are scheduled to make the transition to new narrow band radios on September 1, 2011, well in advance of the deadline; and 25 26 27 WHEREAS, If the Public Works Department does not convert in approximately the same time 28 frame, it will be unable to communicate with HVFD and HPD except by cell phone; a situation that is less 29 than ideal in emergency situations; and 30 31 WHEREAS, One of the hard lessons learned during Hurricane Katrina and other emergencies is 32 that it is of paramount importance that all emergency responders be able to communicate with each other on the same radio frequencies and be able to do so when power lines, phone lines, and cell phone 33 34 communications are disrupted. 35 36 NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF HOMER ORDAINS: 37 38 Section 1. The FY 2011 Operating Budget is hereby amended by appropriating \$24,510.24 from 39 the Public Works Depreciation Reserves for the acquisition of new "narrow band" radios for the Public 40 Works Department in order to meet FCC requirements and improve public safety and emergency response as follows: 41 42 43 Expenditure: 44 45 Account No. Description Amount 46 156.395 PW Narrow Band Radios \$24,510.24 47 48 Section 2.
