7 AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF HOMER, ALASKA, AMENDING  
8 THE 2017 OPERATING BUDGET BY APPROPRIATING FUNDS IN THE  
9 AMOUNT OF \$30,702.00 FROM PORT AND HARBOR RESERVES TO FUND A  
10 WIRELESS CONTROL SYSTEM FOR THE HIGH MAST LIGHT POLES AT THE  
11 HARBOR.

13 WHEREAS, A Request for Proposals was advertised for the Homer High Mast Light LED  
14 Conversion Project with a total budget amount of \$180,000 per Ordinance 16-49 and upon  
15 completion of the process the contract was awarded to Puffin Electric, Inc. by Resolution 17-  
16 016; and

18 WHEREAS, While preparing the RFP staff became aware of additional energy savings of  
19 up to 20% through a wireless control system that gives options to gradually bring the lights to  
20 full power at sundown and reverse order at sunrise, rather than being full off and full on as the  
21 current lights are; and

23 WHEREAS, Staff included an additive alternative in the RFP for the wireless lighting  
24 controls and Puffin Electric, Inc. included in their proposal an additional lighting control  
25 system and product that has received positive reviews; and

27 WHEREAS, This investment into lighting controls gives the harbor the ability to  
28 capitalize on all the potential savings opportunities for the life of this project.

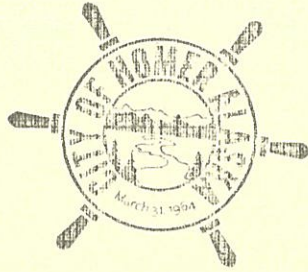

32 Section 1: The FY 2017 Operating budget is hereby amended by appropriating funds in  
33 the amount of \$30,702.00 from Port and Harbor Reserves to fund a Wireless Control System for  
34 the High Mast Light Poles at the Harbor, as follows:
