11	WHEREAS, Currently all City of Homer employees are provided a life insurance policy of
12	one year's base salary (additional insurance can be purchased); and
13	
14	WHEREAS, Currently in the event of the death of an employee dependents participating
15	in the health plan are eligible to purchase continuing heath care coverage through COBRA for
16	up to 36 months; and
17	
18	WHEREAS, Compassion and assistance should be extended to the family of a City
19	employee who dies while performing duties related to their job for the City of Homer.
20	
21	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council recommends amending
22	Chapter 6 of the City of Homer Personnel Regulations to add a new section, Occupational Death
23	Benefit where in the case of the occupational death of an employee, it is the policy of the City
24	to retain the employee's eligible dependents on the City's health plan for 24 months at no cost
25	to the family. Dependents are eligible for this benefit if they are enrolled in the City's healthcare
26	plan at the time of the employee's death.
27	
28	For a death to be considered occupational:
29	1. It must occur before the employee's retirement and before the employee's normal
30	retirement date,
31	2. The proximate cause of death is a bodily injury sustained or a hazard undergone
32	while in the performance and within the scope of the employee's duties, and
33	3. The injury or hazard is not the proximate result of willful negligence of the
34	employee.
