27	a. Upright and flat memorial markers are allowed.		
28	b. No monument or other memorial or plant of any kind shall be placed upon, altered or		
29	removed from the premises by any person without the written consent of the City.		
30	c. All flat markers and/or upright headstones shall be constructed of sandstone or limestone,		
31	marble, granite, or concrete and will be a minimum 24" x 12" x 4" in dimension, not to exceed		
32	48" x 24" x 4" in dimension and set flush with the ground.		
33			
34	<u>Section 2</u> . This ordinance shall take effect upon its adoption by the Homer City Council.		
35 36	Section 3. This ordinance is of a permanent and general character and shall be included		
37	in the City Code.
