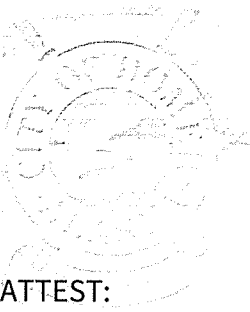
WHEREAS, the Port and Harbor Advisory Commission has further committed Port and Harbor Enterprise Funds to forward fund the remainder of construction cost with the agreement that future Commercial Vessel Passenger Tax Program Pass Through Grant funds will reimburse the Port and Harbor Enterprise Fund those costs; and

WHEREAS, In accordance with LWCF provisions, the City has already committed to maintaining Ramp 2 restroom area in perpetuity for public outdoor recreation.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of Homer, Alaska, supports preparation and submission of a LWCF grant application for up to \$125,000 and authorizes the City Manager to submit the appropriate documents.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Council expresses its commitment to match grant funds with Commercial Vessel Passenger Tax Program Grant funds to meet the grant match requirements.
