NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED the City of Homer will continue to work towards becoming a City that is universally accessible to all. BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the ADA committee will review the draft Comprehensive Plan and make suggestions as to how to prioritize accessibility in our most important planning document. BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED the City of Homer will explore joining the World Health Organizations Global Network of Age-Friendly Cities and Communities.
