6 AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF HOMER, ALASKA,
7 ACCEPTING AND APPROPRIATING AN FY 2017 STATE HOMELAND
8 SECURITY PROGRAM GRANT FOR UPGRADING THE CITY'S RADIO
9 COMMUNICATION SYSTEM AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY
10 MANAGER TO EXECUTE THE APPROPRIATE DOCUMENTS.

12 WHEREAS, The City's entire radio communication system is aging and must be replaced
13 soon to keep up with technological advances in order to support the City of Homer's ability to
14 prevent, protect against, respond to and recover from all hazard events ; and

16 WHEREAS, Radio communication system upgrades is a in the City of Homer Capital
17 Improvement Plan 2017-2022; and

19 WHEREAS, the City is pleased to have been awarded \$92,552.00 from the Division of
20 Homeland Security and Emergency Management (DSH&EM); \$15,282.00 to purchase two backup
21 emergency dispatch radios; \$44,770.00 to replace two City of Homer repeaters with upgraded models;
22 and \$32,500.00 to replace some of the Homer Police Department Mobile Radio units;

24 NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF HOMER ORDAINS:

26 Section 1. The Homer City Council hereby accepts and appropriates a 2017 State
27 Homeland Security Program Grant to the City of Homer from the DHS&EM in the amount of
28 \$92,552.00 for the purpose of upgrading the City's radio communication system as follows:



Section 3. This is a budget amendment ordinance, is temporary in nature, and shall not be codified.



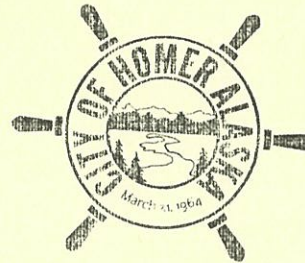


