7 A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF HOMER, ALASKA,
8 APPROVING A NEW ONE-YEAR CONTRACT WITH PREMIERA BLUE
9 CROSS, SUN LIFE HEALTH, AND PRUDENTIAL.

11 WHEREAS, The City of Homer received proposals from private health insurance
12 companies which were evaluated by the consultant and City Administration, and agreed that
13 the best proposal for health insurance was the one submitted by Premera Blue Cross; and

15 WHEREAS, Sun Life Health submitted a proposal for Dental and Vision which would
16 provide the City with a better rate and coverage for those benefits; and
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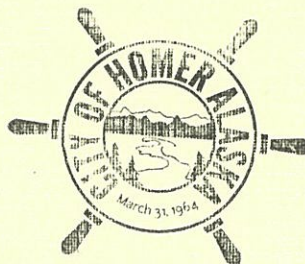
18 WHEREAS, Combining the Premera Blue Cross and Sun Life Health proposals would
19 only raise the 2018 total health care costs by 7.7% over 2017 actual; and
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21 WHEREAS, The Employee Committee had a conference call and discussion with
22 Brandon Nyberg of Wells Fargo Insurance, reviewed the benefit coverage and cost projections
23 for the 2018 plan, and reviewed proposals submitted, and concurs with this recommendation;


26 WHEREAS, In order to meet enrollment deadlines, and have new enrollees' healthcare
27 effective on January 1, 2018, it is necessary to approve the new contracts and employee
28 premiums by the end of November.

30 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Homer City Council hereby approves a new
31 one-year contract based upon the proposals with a term beginning on January 1, 2018, and
32 authorizes the City Manager to execute the appropriate documents.
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
