19 20	amount of water in the soil and every effort needs to be extended to control the amount of
21	water introduced into the soils, including water runoff from the Sterling Highway; and
22	WHEREAS, The City of Homer has maintained ditches and replaced culverts in the
23	Baycrest subdivision to help with drainage; and
24	bay create addativision to net p with drainage, and
25	WHEREAS, The Homer City Council passed Resolution 17-082 directing the Home
26	Advisory Planning Commission to consider a Natural Hazards Overlay District or other
27	appropriate zoning regulation on and around Baycrest Subdivision; and

29	WHEREAS, Alaska Department of Transportation and Public Facilities (ADOT&PF) owns
30	and operates a beehive that collects water off the Sterling Highway at the top of Baycres
31	Subdivision directing water into the subdivision; and

33	WHEREAS, Water from the beehive is not directed into an attended ditch or natural
34	drainage but discharges unrestricted over land with water flow recorded at approximately
35	120,000 gallons in a 24 hour period during heavy rains in December of 2017; and

37	WHEREAS, In response to concerns expressed by residents in the subdivision, ADOT&PF
38	sent Newton Bingham, PE, to evaluate the situation in November of 2017; and

40	WHEREAS, Baycrest Subdivision is at risk for further property damage and a potentially
41	catastrophic slope failure.
