Appointments will be made by the Mayor with approval of the City 24 25 Council. 26 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that Chapter 2, section 2.2 is amended to read: 27 28 29 (A) The City Manager shall establish a Lease Committee that will at a minimum, consist of the Finance Director, the City Planner, and the Port and Harbor Director. The 30 Lease Committee may consult with other department heads such as the Fire Chief, 31 Police Chief and Public Works Director, the City Attorney, or outside professionals 32 33 as need and appropriate. The City Council shall establish a Lease Committee that will consist of one member of the Advisory Port and Harbor Commission, one 34 member of the Advisory Planning Commission; one member of the Advisory 35 Economic Development Commission, 2 community members, one being a city 36 resident and one member of City Council to serve in an advisory non-voting role 37 only. City staff shall serve as staff support to the Committee when appropriate. 38 39 (B) The Lease Committee is responsible for: 40 41 Reviewing the Lease Policies and Procedures as needed and making

recommendations to the City Council on the Lease Policies and Procedures,
