**ORDINANCE 18-24**

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF HOMER, ALASKA,  
AMENDING THE 2018 OPERATING BUDGET BY AUTHORIZING THE  
EXPENDITURE OF AN ADDITIONAL \$79,452 FROM THE HOMER  
ACCELERATED ROAD/TRAIL (HART) FUND TO COMPLETE THE  
GREATLAND STREET EXTENSION PROJECT.

WHEREAS, The City Council, passed Ordinance 18-07, appropriating \$671,053 from the  
Homer Accelerated Roads and Trails Program (HART) for the Greatland Street Improvements  
Project (based on the original project scope); and

WHEREAS, the City Council passed Resolution 18-020(A), directing the design team to  
proceed with the project, including the addition of sidewalk on the east side and providing street  
lighting along the entire length of Greatland Street. This additional work was beyond that  
anticipated in the original budget established under Ordinance 18-07; and

WHEREAS, Public Works coordinated the final design and cost estimate (based on the  
direction of the Council per Resolution 18-020(A) and the cost of the project exceeds the  
previously authorized project budget (see Memorandum 18-050 from Public Works).

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF HOMER ORDAINS:

Section 1. The FY 2018 Operating Budget is hereby amended by appropriating an  
additional \$79,452 from the HART Fund for Greatland Street Extension project.
