6 AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF HOMER, ALASKA
7 AMENDING THE FY2018 CAPITAL BUDGET BY APPROPRIATING
8 \$37,500 FROM THE POLICE STATION RESERVE FOR THE PURPOSE
9 OF FUNDING GEOTECHNICAL INVESTIGATION AND SITE SURVEY
10 FOR THE NEW POLICE STATION.

12 WHEREAS, In recognition of the great need for a safe and hygienic police station, City
13 Council has approved a new police station as the top-ranked priority in the City of Homer's
14 Capital Improvement Plan; and
15

16 WHEREAS, City Council has engaged in a series of worksessions to agree on a preferred
17 site at Heath Street and Grubstake, a cost limit and a proposed funding mechanism that
18 includes a significant local contribution toward the new police station; and
19

20 WHEREAS, It is the intention of City Council to place a bond measure before the voters
21 to approve project financing; and
22

23 WHEREAS, It is important to involve voters in the planning process and to provide
24 sufficient information to the voters and so that they may participate meaningfully in the vote;
25 and

27 WHEREAS, A geotechnical investigation and site survey have not been performed on the
28 selected site; and
29

30 WHEREAS, Information gained from these investigations will help assure that site
31 conditions support the construction cost estimates.

33 NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF HOMER ORDAINS:

35 Section 1. The Homer City Council hereby amends the FY2018 capital budget by
36 appropriating \$37,500 from the Police Station Reserve for the purpose of funding geotechnical
37 investigation and site survey for the new police station.



43 Section 2. The City Manager is authorized to execute the appropriate documents.



46 be codified.

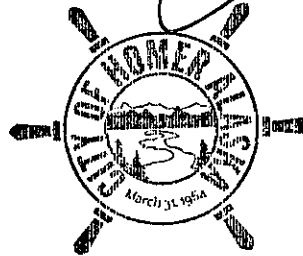


