CITY OF HOMER 1 HOMER, ALASKA 2 City Manager 3 RESOLUTION 18-055 4 5 A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF HOMER ALASKA 6 7 AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO NEGOTIATIONS WITH PENINSULA AIRWAYS, INC., FOR A TWENTY-8 SIX MONTH SUBLEASE AT THE HOMER AIPORT TERMINAL, 9 CONSISTING OF TICKET, OFFICE AREA #110 AND BAGGAGE AREAS. 10 11 WHEREAS, Per Chapter 4 of the Property Management Policy and Procedures Manual, 12 a Request for Proposal to lease airport terminal spaces was advertised in the Homer News 13 December 7 and 14, 2017, posted on the City's website, and noted in the Land Allocation Plan: 14 15 and 16 WHEREAS, On May 4, 2018 Peninsula Airways, Inc. applied for a 26-month, sublease at 17 the rate of \$38,125 annually to be paid in equal monthly installments of \$3,177 per month; and 18 19 WHEREAS, A second air carrier at the Homer Airport provides competition and 20 additional flight times which is good for residents, visitors, and the economic vitality of Homer; 21 and 22 23 WHEREAS, Peninsula Airways, Inc. has filed for Chapter 11 Bankruptcy allowing them to 24 continue operating as their business model restructures which is expected in the fall of 2018; 25 and 26 27 28 WHEREAS, Included in the new lease will be language that provides credit support for the City in the event of a Peninsula Airways, Inc. bankruptcy; and 29 30 31 WHEREAS, City Council is currently in the process of revising Homer City Code 18.08 and 32 property management practices to increase transparency and Council oversight by requiring 33 Council approval of all final lease documents; and 34 35 WHEREAS, Given these anticipated changes, a final lease will require City Council approval no later than the June 25, 2018 City Council meeting in order to meet Peninsula 36 37 Airways, Inc. operational goals and deadlines. 38 39 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED That the City Council of Homer, Alaska, hereby authorizes the City Manager to enter into negotiations with Peninsula Airways, Inc., for a new 40 26-month sublease at the Homer Airport, from July 1, 2018 through September 30, 2020 that 41
