ORDINANCE 18-30

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF HOMER, ALASKA,
AMENDING THE 2018 CAPITAL BUDGET BY APPROPRIATING \$35,911
FROM THE HARBOR DEPRECIATION RESERVE FUND FOR THE
RELOCATION OF THE RAMP 2 HARBOR BACKFLOW PREVENTION
FACILITIES, AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE THE
APPROPRIATE DOCUMENTS.

WHEREAS, The replacement of the Ramp 2 restroom provides the opportunity to bring the
Small Boat Harbor backflow prevention into code compliance, reduce maintenance costs, and
provide for safer operations (see Memorandum 18-172 from Public Works/Harbormaster); and

WHEREAS, Public Works has prepared a plan and proposes to complete the work later this
summer utilizing a competitively selected Contractor and City water distribution/harbor staff.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF HOMER ORDAINS:


Section 1. The FY 2018 Capital Budget is hereby amended by appropriating \$35,911 from


Section 2. This is a budget amendment ordinance, is not permanent in nature, and shall


