We, the Election Canvass Board, duly appointed, of the City of Homer, Alaska hereby certify that the validated absentee and validated questioned ballots were opened, counted, and recorded at a legally authorized and convened meeting of the City of Homer Canvass Board, held June 29, 2018 and that the results of that count are hereon entered with the certified results of the votes counted for the precinct polling places via Accu-Vote Ballot Tabulation System and that the total results are recorded hereon.

## PROPOSITION NO. 1 GENERAL OBLIGATION BONDS FOR A NEW POLICE STATION AND RELATED CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS; 0.35% SALES TAX RATE INCREASE FROM 4.5% TO 4.85%

Shall the City of Homer incur debt and issue general obligation bonds in an amount not to exceed Five Million Dollars (\$5,000,000) to finance the planning, design and construction of a police station and related capital improvements; and shall the rate of City sales tax be increased by thirty five hundredths percent (0.35%) for the purpose of funding public safety operations and infrastructure within the City, including without limitation construction of a police station, with 0.3% of the sales tax rate increase to pay debt service on the general obligation bonds with the 0.3% sales tax rate increase expiring on December 31 of the year when the City has received sufficient funds from that 0.3% sales tax rate increase to pay all of that debt service?

The bonds shall be secured by a pledge of the full faith and credit of the City. (Ordinance 18-26(A)(S)(A))
