1 **CITY OF HOMER** 2 **HOMER, ALASKA** 3 City Clerk/Canvass Board 4 **RESOLUTION 18-058** 5 6 A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF HOMER, ALASKA, 7 ACKNOWLEDGING THE RESULTS OF THE CITY OF HOMER SPECIAL ELECTION HELD JUNE 26, 2018 TO DECIDE ONE QUESTION; SHALL 8 THE CITY OF HOMER INCUR DEBT AND ISSUE GENERAL 9 OBLIGATION BONDS IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED FIVE 10 MILLION DOLLARS (\$5,000,000) TO FINANCE THE PLANNING, 11 DESIGN AND CONSTRUCTION OF A POLICE STATION AND 12 RELATED CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS; AND SHALL THE RATE OF 13 CITY SALES TAX BE INCREASED BY THIRTY FIVE HUNDREDTHS 14 PERCENT (0.35%) FOR THE PURPOSE OF FUNDING PUBLIC 15 SAFETY OPERATIONS AND INFRASTRUCTURE WITHIN THE CITY, 16 INCLUDING WITHOUT LIMITATION CONSTRUCTION OF A POLICE 17 STATION, WITH 0.3% OF THE SALES TAX RATE INCREASE TO PAY 18 DEBT SERVICE ON THE GENERAL OBLIGATION BONDS WITH THE 19 0.3% SALES TAX RATE INCREASE EXPIRING ON DECEMBER 31 OF 20 THE YEAR WHEN THE CITY HAS RECEIVED SUFFICIENT FUNDS 21 FROM THAT 0.3% SALES TAX RATE INCREASE TO PAY ALL OF THAT 22 23 DEBT SERVICE?; AND CONFIRMING THE CERTIFICATION DATE OF JULY 2, 2018. 24 25 26 WHEREAS, In compliance with Homer City Code 4.35, the Canvass Board of the City of Homer has opened, counted, and tallied the votes on absentee ballots including special needs 27 ballots, and question ballots found to be valid, that were cast in the City of Homer Special 28 Election held on June 26, 2018; and 29 30 WHEREAS, The total number of voters voting in the City Special Election was 808 and 31 reflects the number of voters, not the number of votes cast or ballots counted; and 32 33 34 WHEREAS, In accordance with Homer City Code 4.35, the Canvass Board of the City of Homer had inspected the precinct reports, Election Central Logs and entered the the results of 35 the absent and questioned ballots on the Certification of Election along with the results of the 36 37 precinct counts; and 38

WHEREAS, The results of the Special City Election held June 26, 2018, attached as

Exhibit A, is presented in the Canvass Board's Certificate of Election in accordance with the

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council hereby certifies the results of 43 the Special City Election held June 26, 2018, as presented in the Canvass Boards Certificate of 44 Election, attached as Exhibit A, in accordance with the Homer City Code, and confirming the 45 certification date of July 2, 2018. 46 47 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED the results of following questions are as follows: 48 49 50 Proposition No. 1. 51 Shall the City of Homer incur debt and issue general obligation bonds in an amount not to 52 exceed Five Million Dollars (\$5,000,000) to finance the planning, design and construction of a 53 police station and related capital improvements; and shall the rate of City sales tax be 54 increased by thirty five hundredths percent (0.35%) for the purpose of funding public safety 55 operations and infrastructure within the City, including without limitation construction of a 56 police station, with 0.3% of the sales tax rate increase to pay debt service on the general 57 obligation bonds with the 0.3% sales tax rate increase expiring on December 31 of the year 58 when the City has received sufficient funds from that 0.3% sales tax rate increase to pay all of 59 that debt service? 60 61 The bonds shall be secured by a pledge of the full faith and credit of the City.
