1 **CITY OF HOMER** 2 **HOMER, ALASKA** 3 Erickson/Smith 4 **RESOLUTION 18-059** 5 6 A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF HOMER, ALASKA, 7 REQUESTING THE ALASKA BORD OF FISH CONSIDER THE TOPIC 8 OF SALMON ENHANCEMENT IN PRINCE WILLIAM SOUND AT THE 9 REGULARLY SCHEDULED FALL MEETING INSTEAD OF THE JULY 10 17, 2018 SPECIAL MEETING. 11 12 WHEREAS, The Alaska Board of Fisheries has scheduled a special meeting for July 17, 13 2018; and 14 15 WHEREAS, The purpose of the meeting is to address two emergency petitions: the Kenai River Sport Fishing Association received May 16, 2018 regarding additional hatchery 16 17 production in the Prince William Sound, and the Bristol Bay Native Association June 22, 2018 18 resolution 2018-13 regarding sockeye salmon regulations for the Chignik, Kodiak, and the 19 Alaska Peninsula management areas; and 20 21 WHEREAS, Many Prince William Sound permit holders live and maintain their vessels in 22 Homer; and 23 24 WHEREAS, Commercial fishing is a vital part of the Homer economy; and 25 WHEREAS, The Homer City Council has a duty to represent constituents when the 26 27 actions of other bodies have an adverse economic impact; and 28 WHEREAS, Holding/a special meeting with short notice when stakeholders are busy 29 30 fishing and cannot provide input lacks transparency; and 31 32 WHEREAS, The additional hatchery production in Prince William Sound has already been approved and bermitted through an established regulatory process; and 33 34 35 WHEREAS, The regularly scheduled Board of Fish meeting in the fall is the appropriate 36 time to take up these topics where sufficient notice can be given and all stakeholders can be 37 present. 38 39 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of Homer, Alaska, requests the 40 Alaska Board of Fish consider the topic of salmon enhancement in Prince William Sound at the 41 regularly scheduled fall meeting instead of the July 17, 2018 special meeting. 42
