1 **CITY OF HOMER** 2 **HOMER, ALASKA** 3 City Manager/ 4 Public Works Director 5 **EMERGENCY ORDINANCE 18-48** 6 7 AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF HOMER, ALASKA, 8 APPROPRIATING \$22,000 TO FUND EMERGENCY SEAWALL 9 REPAIRS AND AUTHORIZING A SOLE SOURCE CONTRACT WITH 10 EAST ROAD SERVICES TO PERFORM THE REPAIRS. 11 12 WHEREAS, The Homer City Council adopted Emergency Ordinance 11-49(S) which 13 created the Ocean Drive Loop Special Service District; and 14 15 WHEREAS, The Special Service District was created to raise tax revenues from 16 benefitted property owners to support maintenance and repair of the seawall they own which 17 is located on their properties; and 18 19 WHEREAS, As a tax-exempt property owner along the seawall, the City contributes 20 \$10,000 annually to a Seawall Reserve Account for the City's portion of repairs to the seawall; 21 and 22 23 WHEREAS, Repairs to the seawall have to be performed on an emergency basis in order 24 to prevent further damage and remain in compliance with the Army Corps of Engineers permit 25 for the seawall. 26 27 WHEREAS, Ordinance 18-06 appropriated \$28,946 for emergency repairs, the 5 year 28 average cost of repairs; and 29 30 WHEREAS, Fall storms have done an estimated \$50,000 in damage to the toe of the wall 31 which exceed the budgetary authorization in Ordinance 18-06; and 32 33 WHEREAS, East Road Services is familiar with the seawall having constructed and 34 maintained the seawall; and 35 36 WHEREAS, Due to the emergency nature of the work that needs to be done, a sole 37 source contract is necessary and authorized in HCC 3.16.060(c). 38 39 NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF HOMER ORDAINS: 40 41 <u>Section 1</u>. The Homer City Council hereby appropriates an additional \$21,054 from the 42 Seawall Maintenance Reserve and Ocean Drive Loop Special Service District for the purpose of 43 repairing and maintaining the seawall as follows:

The City Manager is authorized to enter into a sole source contract with East Road Services to perform the repairs representing \$21,054 authorized in this ordinance 54 55 combined with the \$28,946 previously authorized. 56 57 Section 3.
