11 12	WHEREAS, Homer City Code 4.35.020 provides that to be elected to the Council, a
13	candidate must receive more than the plurality of the total votes cast for all candidates for Council divided by the number of seats filled; and
14	Council divided by the number of seats filled, and
15	WHEREAS, Homer City Code 4.35.020 defines a plurality of votes as a percentage of total
16	votes cast in the election and the same percentage is used for both Mayoral and Council
17	elections; and
18	
19	WHEREAS, Two seats on the Council are open for election each year requiring that the
20	total votes cast for all candidates be divided by two; and
21	
22	WHEREAS, When calculating the percentage of the vote required to achieve a plurality
23	in order to determine election results, the percentages for Council Member elections are, in
24	effect, doubled when compared to the percentages required for a plurality in the Mayoral vote;
25	and
26	
27	WHEREAS, This method of calculating a plurality in Council Member elections often
28	creates confusion on how to calculate the required percentages to achieve a plurality; and
29	
30	WHEREAS, Eliminating the requirement to divide the total votes cast by two when
31	calculating whether a plurality of votes has been achieved in Council Member elections and
32	correspondingly amending the required percentage of the vote that is required to achieve a
33	plurality by dividing that percentage by two such that a candidate for council would need to
34	receive 20% of the votes cast when there are less than five candidates and 17.5% of the votes
35	when there are five or more candidates is a clearer way to define how a plurality is calculated;

38	to be elected to fill a vacancy in the office of Mayor and a vacant council seat; and
