1 CITY OF HOMER 2 **HOMER, ALASKA** 3 Smith 4 **RESOLUTION 19-011** 5 6 A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF HOMER, ALASKA, 7 DELETING LANGUAGE IN THE CITY OF HOMER FEE SCHEDULE 8 UNDER CAMPING FEES. 9 WHEREAS, Homer City Code 2.32.040 provides authority for the director of each 10 department of the City, subject to the approval of the City Manager and ratification by the City 11 Council, to promulgate and maintain an administrative fee schedule for services provided by 12 13 that department; and 14 15 WHEREAS, The fee schedule contains information relevant to the assessment of fees and is reviewed annually by departments and submitted to City Council for approval; and 16 17 WHEREAS, The language in the Port and Harbor section matches that of the Port of 18 19 Homer Tariff No. 1 and are amended simultaneously; and 20 21 WHEREAS, The language in the Water and Sewer sections was reviewed by the Water and Sewer Rate Task Force and is reviewed by Council annually and amended as needed; and 22 23 WHEREAS, The remaining sections of the fee schedule contain information identifying 24 25 what the fee is for, but do not include specific code definitions, with the exception of the 26 camping section; and 27 28 WHEREAS, Resolution 05-05 amended the fee schedule to include code language defining camping to differentiate between the fees at Karen Hornaday Park (then Hillside Park) 29 than on the Homer Spit; and 30 31 32 WHEREAS, The fee scheduled has since been amended so that all camping fees are the same for tent camping or for RV camping at City owned camp sites and the language included 33 under camping no longer serves the purpose it did in prior years; and 34 35 WHEREAS, Definitions are updated in City Code as needed and having this definition in 36 the fee schedule creates a clerical challenge when updates occur and are not carried over 37 because there is no trigger to do so as with the Port Terminal Tariff or water and sewer rate 38 reviews. 39 40 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City of Homer Fee Schedule is hereby 41 42 amended under Camping Fees as follows:

44	"Camping" means:
45	1. The erection of, or occupancy of any tent.
46	2. The placing or leaving of any items normally found at a campsite within
47	campsite such as cook stoves, lanterns, sleeping bags or bedding.
48	3. Parking of any camper unit in any area owned or controlled by the City that ha
49	been designated a camping area by official signs, in excess of twenty-four hours.
