18	WHEREAS, It is in the interest of the City of Homer ("City") to prioritize providing City-	
19	owned utilities to City residents and taxpayers; and

21	WHEREAS, The City has no authority to regulate the development or zo	oning of real
22	property outside the City's boundaries; and	
23	WILLEDEAS. Dreportion outside City limits do not contribute to the costs of	maintaining
24 25	WHEREAS, Properties outside City limits do not contribute to the costs of maintaining	
25 26	and providing City-owned public utilities through property tax, public utility ass in the case of businesses, sales tax; and	essments or,

28	WHEREAS, For these reasons the water service area of the City should not	he exnanded
29	outside City limits without careful and deliberate consideration by City Council v	•
30	or as otherwise required by law.

32	NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF HOMER ORDAINS:

34	Section 1. The Homer City Council hereby amends Homer City Code 14.08,	"Water Rules
35	and Regulations" by adding a new section HCC 14.08.015 entitled "Water Service	Area":

37	14.08.015 Water Service Area

39	a. Except as otherwise required by law, the City may only extend permit co	
40	City-owned water service outside City boundaries when the extensio	
41	requested by the governing body of the outside jurisdiction via ordina	nce and the

42		extension is approved by Council via ordinance and in full compliance with this Section.
43		The ordinance approved by Council must:
44		
45		1. Identify the location of the property or properties to be serviced;
46		2. Identify and incorporate by reference any applicable agreements between the
47		City and the jurisdiction in which the property is or properties are located;
48		3. Identify essential terms and conditions of the agreement that must be included
49		in any agreement between the property owner, the City, and/or the jurisdiction
50		in which the property is or properties are located;
51		4. Specify the cost of extending providing City water service to the identified
52		property and the required cost allocation method of any costs and fees
53		associated with connecting to the water main, including costs associated
54		with the original main extension, for the property or properties;
55		5. Affirm that the cost allocation method and the amount paid by the property
56		owner and/or the jurisdiction where the property is located includes the full
57		costs and fees of the extension and does not disadvantage property owners
58		within the City; and
59		6. Affirm the extension of connection to water services under this section is lawful,
60		in the City's best interest, and in furtherance of public health and welfare within
61		the City.
62		7. Include a resolution from the Homer Planning Commission affirming that,
63		the proposed connection fully complies with and meets the goals of the City
64		<u>Comprehensive Plan.</u>
65		
66	b.	Notwithstanding the other provisions of this Section Unless otherwise required by
67		law and subject to the requirements of this Section, after [insert effective date of
68		this ordinance], properties outside City boundaries may only access the City-owned
69		Water System may only be extended to properties outside City boundaries if the
70		property seeking access is adjacent to a water main that serves property within the
71		City.

73	с. –	-If an outside jurisdiction agrees to undertake, in whole or part, any financial,
74		managerial or operational role in the extension, operation or use of the Water System,
75		this agreement must be approved by Council via resolution.
76		
77	d.	Before <u>connection to</u> City-owned water service may be extended <u>permitted</u> outside
78		it's City borders under this Section, Council must approve an Extraterritorial Water
79		System Agreement between the City and the owner of extraterritorial property
80		receiving City-owned water service.

82	e.	The essential terms of the Extraterritorial Water System Agreement must:

84	:	L. Identify the location of the property, the intended and existing use of the
85		property, and the reason for requesting the extension of connection to the City-
86		owned property water main to the property;
87		2. Specify the amount of the extension, the cost allocation of any costs and fees
88		associated with the extension connecting to the water main, including costs
89		associated with the original main extension and the specific terms of any
90		payment method for the property;
91		3. Incorporate all City laws, policies, and procedures governing the extension
92		connection , installation, operation, and maintenance of the City-owned Water
93		System;
94 95	2	 Incorporate any applicable agreements between the City and the jurisdiction in which the property is located; and
96	<u> </u>	5. Require the property owner to consent to and confirm that the City has full
97		authority to regulate any use of the property that has or may have an impact on
98		the City-owned Water System.

100	f. Con	nection to City Wwater may not be extended outside City limits until the City
101		ends its certificate of public convenience and necessity to include the extended
102		mitted service area, if required by state law.
