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6 A RESOLUTION OF THE HOMER CITY COUNCIL APPROVING THE  
7 AMERICANS WITH DISABILITIES ACT TRANSITION PLAN FOR CITY  
8 OF HOMER FACILITIES.  
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10 WHEREAS, The Americans with Disability Act (ADA) requires that State and local  
11 governments comply with Title II of the ADA that covers programs, activities, and services of  
12 public entities; and  
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14 WHEREAS, Title II is intended to protect qualified individuals with disabilities from  
15 discrimination on the basis of disability in the services, programs, or activities of all State and  
16 local governments; and  
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18 WHEREAS, The Homer City Council established the ADA Compliance Committee via  
19 Resolution 16-019 to develop a transition plan and establish a grievance procedure; and  
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21 WHEREAS, Members of the ADA Compliance Committee and City staff performed  
22 evaluations of City buildings, including public restrooms, and some amenities in the Homer  
23 harbor; and  
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25 WHEREAS, A representative from the Northwest ADA Center worked with staff and the  
26 Committee to survey the Homer harbor; and  
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28 WHEREAS, The Transition Plan is a living document that identifies barriers and sets out  
29 a schedule to take action to address the barriers and improve accessibility to City facilities for  
30 all; and  
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32 WHEREAS, The ADA Compliance Committee will review and update the Transition Plan  
33 annually or as needed to identify work completed, add barriers that may arise in the future,  
34 and identify interim steps as needed when achieving compliance will take longer than a year  
35 to accomplish; and  
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37 WHEREAS, The Committee will provide updates to the Transition Plan to the City  
38 Council under Committee reports.  
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40 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Homer City Council approves the the ADA  
41 Transition Plan for City of Homer Facilities.
