29	WHEREAS, For all the reasons listed above, clarifying Homer City Code to specify that	эt
30	the Mayor shall vote in the case of a tie is in the best interest of the City.

34	Section 1. HCC Section 2.08.040(h) is hereby amended as follows:

36	h. Quorum – Voting. Four Council members shall constitute a quorum. Fou	ır
37	affirmative votes are required for the passage of an ordinance, resolution, or motion	
38	A member of the Council acting as Mayor Pro Tem shall not lose his vote as the resu	
39	of serving in such office. The Mayor is not a Council member and <del>may vote only</del> <b>sha</b>	
40	vote only in the case of a tie. The final vote on each ordinance, resolution, or	
41	substantive motion may be a roll call vote or may be done in accordance wit	h
42	subsection (k) of this section (see AS 29.20.160(c)(d)).
