ORDINANCE 19-46

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF HOMER, ALASKA,
AMENDING HOMER CITY CODE CHAPTER 2.60, PARKS, ART,
RECREATION, AND CULTURE ADVISORY COMMISSION, SECTION
2.60.010(A) CREATED-MEMBERSHIP, TO REDUCE THE NUMBER OF
MEMBERS FROM NINE TO SEVEN.

WHEREAS, The Parks, Art, Recreation, and Culture Advisory Commission voted
unanimously to reduce the membership to seven voting members at their April 18, 2019 regular
meeting.

NOW, THEREFORE, The City of Homer Ordains:

Section 1. HCC Chapter 2.60 Parks, Art, Recreation, and Culture Advisory Commission
Section 2.60.010(a), Created-Membership is hereby amended to read as follows:

a. There shall be a City of Homer Parks, Art, Recreation and Culture Advisory
Commission, hereinafter referred to as the Commission. The Commission will be
composed of ~~nine~~ **seven** voting members, who shall be appointed by the Mayor and
confirmed by the City Council, plus one nonvoting member who shall be a Homer area
high school student selected by his or her student body. Up to three voting members of
the Commission may be nonresidents of the City, but City resident applicants shall be
preferred for all Commission member appointments.

b. A Chair and Vice-Chair of the Commission shall be elected annually from and by the
voting members of the Commission. The Chair shall preside at meetings of the
Commission. In the absence of the Chair, the Vice-Chair shall perform the duties of the
Chair. [Ord. 16-22 § 2, 2016].

Section 2. This ordinance is of a permanent and general character and shall be included
in Homer City Code.




