CITY OF HOMER 1 HOMER, ALASKA 2 Smith 3 4 **RESOLUTION 20-009** 5 A RESOLUTION OF THE HOMER CITY COUNCIL APPROVING AN 6 AUTOMATIC AID AGREEMENT AND OPERATIONAL PLAN BETWEEN 7 ANCHOR POINT FIRE AND EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICE AREA 8 AND THE CITY OF HOMER VOLUNTEER FIRE DEPARTMENT FOR 9 FIRE RESPONSE SERVICES AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY 10 MANAGER EXECUTE THE APPROPRIATE DOCUMENTS. 11 12 WHEREAS, Automatic aid agreements are a form of mutual aid agreements and their 13 operational plans provide for automatic requests for additional resources to residents of the 14 peninsula in the form of fire response personnel and apparatus when required; and 15 16 WHEREAS, Automatic aid agreements and operational plans are common in the fire and 17 18 emergency service professions; and 19 WHEREAS, Alaska Statute 18.70.150 provides that: "[a] city, other incorporated entity, 20 and other fire protection groups may organize a mutual-aid program by adopting an ordinance 21 or resolution authorizing and permitting their fire department, fire company, emergency relief 22 squad, fire police squad, or fire patrol to go to the aid of another city, incorporated entity, or 23 24 fire protection group, or territory outside of it..."; and 25 26 WHEREAS, This automatic aid agreement and operational plan between Anchor Point 27 Fire & Emergency Medical Service Area ("APFEMSA") and the City of Homer Volunteer Fire Department ("HVFD") sets forth response areas and terms of automatic aid; and 28 29 WHEREAS, All associated costs are borne by each responding agency, and in this 30 manner, costs for manpower, materials, supplies and equipment are exchanged between the 31 agencies, ultimately resulting in service area funds being expended for the benefit of the 32 33 service area; and 34 WHEREAS, For years, the operational plans have been considered as matters within the 35 expertise of the agencies providing automatic aid and, therefore, future amendments to the 36 operational plans have been left to the discretion of the agencies; and 37 38 WHEREAS, Significant cost savings for fire insurance can be afforded local taxpayers 39 through rating determinations by the Insurance Services Office (ISO) when automatic aid 40 agreements are in effect; and 41
