7 REAFFIRMING THEIR COMMITMENT TO PROVIDE INDOOR
8 RECREATION OPPORTUNITIES TO AREA RESIDENTS VIA A MULTI-
9 USE COMMUNITY CENTER.

11 WHEREAS, Homer City Council appropriated \$35,000 in the 2020 capital budget to fund
12 a hazardous material and demolition cost estimate for HERC 1 and HERC 2; and

14 WHEREAS, The results of the study are anticipated by spring; and

16 WHEREAS, Homer City Council listed a Multi-Use Community Center, Phase 1 as one of
17 the top five legislative priorities in the 2021 Capital Improvement Plan adopted via Resolution
18 19-061; and

20 WHEREAS, Homer City Council listed HERC Demolition and Community Recreation
21 Center next steps as their number one large priority Council-Initiated project for 2020 adopted
22 via Memorandum 20-015; and

23
24 WHEREAS, Once demolition costs are determined, next steps will be site selection and
25 preliminary design for a new Multi-Use Community Center.



29 determining next steps for the HERC facilities.

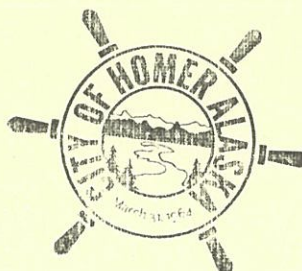
