6 AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF HOMER,
7 ALASKA, AMENDING THE 2020 BUDGET BY APPROPRIATING
8 FUNDS IN THE AMOUNT OF \$50,000 FROM THE GENERAL FUND
9 FUND BALANCE FOR THE PURPOSE OF COVID-19 PREPARATION
10 AND RESPONSE.

12 WHEREAS, On Friday, March 13, 2020, the President of The United States of America
13 declared a national emergency due to COVID-19; and

14
15 WHEREAS, On March 11, 2020, the Governor of the State of Alaska issued a Public Health
16 Disaster Emergency Declaration for COVID-19; and

17
18 WHEREAS, On March 18, 2020, the Mayor of the City of Homer declared a Local Health
19 Emergency due to COVID-19; and

20
21 WHEREAS, Preparing for COVID-19 and implementing CDC recommendations on social
22 distancing and closures of public facilities will require emergency expenditures; and

24 WHEREAS, Many of the expenditures will be related to securing internet capability and
25 physical devices for City employees to be able to telework; and

26
27 WHEREAS, The expenditures may be eligible for Federal Emergency Manager
28 Association (FEMA) reimbursement; and

29
30 WHEREAS, Creating separate spending authority unique to COVID-19 will assist in the
31 tracking and documentation for response and reimbursement.

33 NOW, THEREFORE, The City of Homer Ordains:

35 Section 1: The FY 2020 budget is hereby amended by appropriating funds in the amount
36 of \$50,000 from the General Fund Fund Balance for the purpose of COVID-19 preparation and
37 response:





47 not be codified.

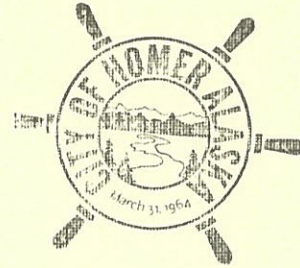


