6 A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF HOMER, ALASKA,
7 NOTING THE INSUFFICIENCY OF THE PETITION FOR FOREST
8 GLEN ROAD RECONSTRUCTION AND PAVING SPECIAL
9 ASSESSMENT DISTRICT.

11 WHEREAS, On June 26, 2020 an application to initiate a special assessment district for
12 road reconstruction and paving on Forest Glen Drive was filed and a petition was created and
13 sent by certified mail to 46 property owners of 54 parcels in the district; and

14
15 WHEREAS, Homer City Code 17.02.040 (a)(2) states a special assessment district may be
16 initiated by a petition signed by 50 percent of the total record owners who receive notice from
17 the City Clerk's office that they will be assessed a portion of the costs of a single capital
18 improvement; and



20 WHEREAS, Twelve property owners who own 13 parcels in the proposed district signed
21 the petition initiating the special assessment district.

23 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of Homer, Alaska, notes the
24 insufficiency of the petition for Forest Glen Drive Road Reconstruction and Paving
25 Improvements.

27 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED this does not preclude further petitioning by property
28 owners for road improvements for a modified area or any other type of improvement by
29 initiating a new petition.


