ORDINANCE 20-65

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF HOMER, ALASKA,
AMENDING THE 2020 BUDGET BY APPROPRIATING FUNDS IN THE
AMOUNT OF \$271,281 FOR PERSONNEL COSTS ASSOCIATED
WITH COVID-19 PREPARATION AND RESPONSE.

WHEREAS, On March 11, 2020, the Governor of the State of Alaska issued a Public Health
Disaster Emergency Declaration for COVID-19; and

WHEREAS, On March 13, 2020, the President of the United States of America declared a
national emergency due to COVID-19; and

WHEREAS, On March 18, 2020, the Mayor of the City of Homer declared a Local Health
Emergency due to COVID-19 which has been extended through October 27, 2020 with the
passage of Resolution 20-069; and

WHEREAS, Preparing and responding to COVID-19 requires available funding as the City
did not anticipate these expenditures; and

WHEREAS, The City Manager will present Council with an ordinance to re-appropriate
CARES Act dollars to ensure expenses incurred from the COVID-19 pandemic are reimbursed
by this funding mechanism.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF HOMER ORDAINS:

Section 1: The FY 2020 budget is hereby amended by appropriating funds in the amount
of \$271,281 from the General Fund Fund Balance for the purpose of personnel costs associated
with COVID-19 preparation and response:

Section 2: The Finance Department will continue to manage the project account for
COVID-19 Response in order to track all project related expenses with the intent for their full
reimbursement being sought from State, Federal, and Borough assistance.

Section 3: This is a budget amendment ordinance, is not permanent in nature, and shall
not be codified.


