CITY OF HOMER 1 2 HOMER, ALASKA 3 Hansen-Cavasos **ORDINANCE 20-75** 4 5 AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF HOMER, ALASKA, 6 PROVIDING FOR A GRANT OF \$230,000.00 TO SOUTH PENINSULA 7 8 BEHAVIORAL SERVICES, INC FOR THE PURPOSES OF RECOVERY 9 OF LOSSES AND ADDITIONAL COSTS ASSOCIATED WITH MEETING THE CHALLENGES OF THE NOVEL CORONAVIRUS AND IN 10 11 SUPPORT OF THE CONTINUATION OF THEIR PROGRAMS AND SERVICES 12 13 WHEREAS, South Peninsula Behavioral Health Services (SPBHS) operates out of six 14 15 buildings in Homer; and 16 17 WHEREAS, SPBHS's services are in the fields of Mental Health, Substance Misuse and 18 Developmental Disability; and 19 WHEREAS, SPBHS has provided treatment and support services to patients and their 20 families in Homer for forty years; and 21 22 23 WHEREAS, At the onset of the novel Coronavirus pandemic, many of the programs, housed in the various facilities, were discontinued; and 24 25 WHEREAS, Quarantine and "hunkering down" mandates by the State of Alaska resulted 26 in shifting into health and medical care delivered by alternative, but far less personal, 27 technologies; and 28 29 WHEREAS, SPBHS has withstood losses of about \$23,000 a week over the course of the 30 31 pandemic; and 32 WHEREAS, SPBHS has maintained its workforce and services thus far only due to having 33 sufficient reserves and obtaining some supplemental grants; and 34 35 WHEREAS, It seems likely that SPBHS will continue with "telehealth" practices into 36 2021; and 37 38 39 WHEREAS, The City of Homer has received CARES Act funds that may be used to respond to, and recover from, the effects of the novel Coronavirus. 40 41 NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF HOMER ORDAINS: 42

43 Section 1. \$230,000 is appropriated to South Peninsula Behavioral Health Services, Inc. 44 for expenses and increased costs incurred in response to the COVID-19 pandemic for program 45 and service expenditures. 46 47 Section 2.
