1 CITY OF HOMER 2 HOMER, ALASKA 3 Mayor 4 **ORDINANCE 20-79(A)** 5 6 AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF HOMER, ALASKA, 7 ESTABLISHING A FISHERMEN ECONOMIC RECOVERY GRANT 8 (FERG) PROGRAM AND AMENDING THE 2020 BUDGET BY 9 APPROPRIATING THE AMOUNT OF \$1.3 MILLION FROM THE GENERAL FUND FUND BALANCE COVID-19 RESPONSE FUND TO 10 PROVIDE ECONOMIC RELIEF TO CITY OF HOMER-BASED VESSEL 11 12 OWNERS ENGAGED IN COMMERCIAL FISHING WHO ARE 13 IMPACTED BY THE COVID-19 PANDEMIC. 14 WHEREAS, The City of Homer received \$7,899,085.29 in federal funding under the 15 16 Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security Act (CARES Act) from the State of Alaska that allows municipalities to provide small business grants to businesses that suffer economic 17 impacts costs with the Covid-19 pandemic; and 18 19 20 WHEREAS, The City of Homer-based commercial fishing fleet is an important sector of Homer's diverse economy providing jobs and supporting local marine trades and chandleries, 21 job provision and fish deliveries; and 22 23 24 WHEREAS, The Commercial fishing industry has suffered economic loss due to the softening of markets, including restaurants, public and private gatherings and the general loss 25 of normal distribution outlets; and 26 27 WHEREAS, Commercial fishermen have suffered economic loss due to reductions or 28 elimination of stock assessments and surveys which have led to more conservative 29 management with reduced quotas or fishing time; and 30 31 32 WHEREAS, Commercial fishermen have suffered economic loss due to the added expenses of meeting quarantine, social distancing, and other restrictions that have been 33 placed on the commercial fleets during the COVID 19 pandemic; and 34 35 WHEREAS, the continued disruption of economic re-openings around the world may 36 prolong the softening of markets, creating a serious, and in many cases critical, danger to their 37 economic viability; and 38 39 WHEREAS, The Homer City Council believes the Covid-19 pandemic and actions taken 40

as a result to protect public health as described above have created immediate necessity for

economic relief to the City of Homer-based commercial fishing fleet.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF HOMER ORDAINS: 44 45 46 Section 1. The Fisherman Economic Relief Grant (FERG) program is hereby established 47 in accordance with the FERG policy document for the purpose of providing economic relief through the FERG program to City of Homer-based vessel owners engaged in commercial 48 fishing who are impacted by the covid-19 pandemic. 49 50 51 Section 2. The FY2020 budget is hereby amended by appropriating funds in the amount of \$1,300,000.00 for the FERG program. 52 53 54 Section 3. The Finance Department will continue to manage the project account for COVID-19 Response in order to track all project related costs. 55 56 57 Section 4.
