1 CITY OF HOMER 2 HOMER, ALASKA 3 Mayor 4 **ORDINANCE 20-80** 5 6 AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF HOMER, ALASKA, 7 PROVIDING FOR A GRANT OF \$34,789.24 TO THE HOMER 8 FOUNDATION HOMER COMMUNITY CHEST FUND TO ASSIST 9 VULNERABLE POPULATIONS IN ORDER TO PREVENT 10 HOMELESSNESS DURING THE COVID-19 PANDEMIC THROUGH THE HOMER COMMUNITY CHEST FUND. 11 12 13 WHEREAS, The Homer Foundation's Community Chest Fund is dedicated to providing 14 emergency and bridge funding as a safety net for families with children in times of need, and other individuals as extraordinary circumstances might dictate; and 15 16 WHEREAS, The Homer Community Chest Fund distributes this funding through the 17 Non-Food Emergency Aid program in partnership with the Homer Food Pantry, which is one of 18 19 the only programs to help those in need in the community address non-food crises that could 20 otherwise threaten a household's ability to stay sheltered, healthy, and able to meet other 21 needs like transportation, employment and medical care; and 22 23 WHEREAS, Meeting these needs for Homer's vulnerable population is necessary to 24 assist in preventing homelessness, which in turn facilitates a families compliance with COVID-25 19 public health precautions; and 26 27 WHEREAS, It is in the best interest of the City to support this safety net, which keeps 28 people housed, supported, and as healthy as possible to mitigate the effects of COVID-19 and 29 its transmission in the Homer community; and 30 WHEREAS, Since the pandemic began in March through August 2020, the Non-Food 31 32 Emergency Aid program has spent \$16,789.24 supporting individuals and households in need; 33 34 WHEREAS, Based on historical data to project expenses for September through 35 December, the Homer Foundation anticipates the Homer Community Chest will need an 36 additional \$18,000 to cover Non-Food Emergency Aid program expenses; and 37 38 WHEREAS, According to the September 2, 2020 Coronavirus Relief Fund Frequently 39 Asked Questions document, providing a consumer grant program to prevent eviction and 40 assist in preventing homelessness is considered an eligible expense for Cares Act funds; and 41 WHEREAS, The Homer Foundation considers this direct grant to the Homer Community 42 Chest Fund as a means to cover necessary expenses incurred due to the COVID-19 public health
