1 **CITY OF HOMER** 2 HOMER, ALASKA 3 City Manager 4 **RESOLUTION 20-104** 5 6 A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF HOMER, ALASKA, 7 ADOPTING THE CARES ACT PROJECT CLOSE OUT PLAN. 8 WHEREAS, Only expenses that were not accounted for in the City's budget and resulting 9 from the City's response to COVID-19 during the period of March 1, 2020 through December 30, 10 2020 are reimbursed with Coronavirus Relief Funds; and 11 12 13 WHEREAS, In response to COVID-19, the City of Homer has allocated Coronavirus Relief Funds received from a grant agreement with the State of Alaska to reimburse for expenses 14 incurred by the City responding directly to the emergency such as expenses resulting from 15 16 addressing public health needs; and 17 WHEREAS, The City of Homer has also incurred expenses in order to respond to second-18 order effects of the COVID-19 emergency, such as providing economic support to those 19 suffering from employment or business interruptions due to COVID-19-related business 20 21 closures; and 22 23 WHEREAS, These second-order effects specifically include the City of Homer's economic relief grant programs and direct grant assistance to organizations; and 24 25 26 WHEREAS, The economic relief grant programs are providing economic support to small businesses, nonprofits, childcare providers, social service organizations, and 27 households, demonstrating the City of Homer has incurred expenses as a result of COVID-19 in 28 order to stabilize these necessary, critical components that comprise the Homer community; 29 30 and 31 32 WHEREAS, To maximize the community impact of Coronavirus Relief Funds within the remaining eligibility period for reimbursing the City for necessary, unbudgeted costs incurred 33 as a result of the COVID-19 emergency, the City of Homer has developed a CARES Act Project 34 35 Close Out Plan that has prioritized eligible uses of the remaining balance of City of Homer 36 Coronavirus Relief Funds; and 37 38 WHEREAS, The CARES Act Project Close Out Plan directs staff to incur expenses associated with programs and projects as directed by Council and that once each program or 39 40 project is complete, the unexpended balance will be made available for the next prioritized

use; and

RESOLUTION 20-104 WHEREAS, Once the eligible period to use Coronavirus Relief Funds ends after 42 December 30, 2020, staff will present Council with an ordinance detailing all expenses to be 43 applied to the remaining balance of the Coronavirus Relief Funds maintained by the City in the 44 COVID-19 Response Fund; and 45 46 WHEREAS, Any unexpended Coronavirus Relief Funds must be returned to the State of 47 Alaska by March 30, 2021. 48 49 NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the City of Homer adopts the CARES Act Project 50 Close Out Plan. 51 52 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the CARES Act Project Close Out Plan provides staff 53 54 direction on incurring expenses associated with community and city needs related to the COVID-19 pandemic response. 55 56 57 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that amendments to how programs or projects are prioritized, including the addition of new programs or projects, will be made by resolution. 58 59 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that all necessary, unbudgeted, eligible expenses incurred 60 by the City of Homer as a result of the COVID-19 pandemic will be reimbursed with remaining 61 Coronavirus Relief Funds. 62 63 64 65

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that staff will provide Council with regular reports detailing costs incurred through the CARES Act Project Close Out Plan so that City Council can adjust the Plan as needed to respond to COVID-19.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that staff will present Council with an ordinance detailing all expenses to be applied to the remaining balance of the Coronavirus Relief Funds maintained by the City in the COVID-19 Response Fund.
