CITY OF HOMER 1 HOMER, ALASKA 2 3 City Manager Public Works Director 4 5 **RESOLUTION 20-107** 6 7 A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF HOMER, ALASKA, AWARDING A SHORT-TERM TERM CONTRACT FOR 8 9 PROFESSIONAL ENGINEERING SERVICES TO BISHOP 10 ENGINEERING, LLC AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO NEGOTIATE AND EXECUTE THE APPROPRIATE 11 DOCUMENTS. 12 13 WHEREAS, Public Works maintains seven engineering services term contracts which are 14 awarded through a competitive qualifications based procedure; and 15 16 WHEREAS, The existing contracts were awarded in 2017 and will expire in 2022; and 17 18 WHEREAS, None of these contracts are with local firms, since at the time the selection 19 20 process was completed there were no local firms with the capacity to complete significant City projects; and 21 22 WHEREAS, The City encourages Departments to use local businesses whenever possible 23 (i.e. – 5% local bidders preference); and 24 25 WHEREAS, The firm of Bishops Engineering, LLC of Homer, Alaska has gained 26 considerable local knowledge, experience and capacity and is expected to be able to complete 27 28 work at a lower cost and engage other local businesses more effectively than firms located outside of Homer; and 29 30 WHEREAS, The ability to access the local engineering services now available through 31 Bishop Engineering would be greatly enhanced if a term contract was in place with this firm; 32 33 and 34 WHEREAS, All term contracts will expire in 2022 and a new competitive process will be 35 completed; and 36 37 WHEREAS, This award is not final until written notification is received by the firm from 38 the City of Homer. 39 40 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of Homer, Alaska, based on 41 the value of having a term contract with a local firm, awards a short-term term (from October 42 2020 to April 2022) contract for engineering services to Bishop Engineering, LLC of Homer, 43

Alaska, and authorizes the City Manager to negotiate and execute the appropriate documents.
