1 **CITY OF HOMER** 2 HOMER, ALASKA 3 City Manager 4 Public Works Director 5 RESOLUTION 20-111(S)(A) 6 A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF HOMER, ALASKA, 7 THE HOMER 8 AWARDING CONTRACTS FOR 9 MAINTENANCE SERVICES TO (A) EAST ROAD SERVICES OF HOMER, ALASKA IN THE AMOUNT OF \$44,736 10 11 LABOR/EQUIPMENT AND (B) DIBBLE CREEK ROCK, LTD IN THE 12 AMOUNT OF \$42,000 FOR SHOT ROCK AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE THE APPROPRIATE DOCUMENTS. 13 14 15 WHEREAS, Homer's Procurement Manual requires that any contract, which exceeds the value of \$25,000, and is not listed in the City's annual budget, must be approved by the City 16 17 Council; and 18 19 WHEREAS, The Procurement Manual provides that contracts having an estimated value of more than \$25,000 are to be procured as follows: 20 1. advertised for bid in a newspaper of general circulation in the City 21 for not less than two weeks prior to the date of bid award, unless 22 another form of media is authorized by the City Manager; and 23 24 2. the bid closing date shall be no sooner than five working days after 25 the last date of advertisement; and 26 3. the contract shall be awarded to the lowest responsive and 27 responsible bidder; and 28 29 WHEREAS, The Procurement Manual provides for exceptions to certain procurement actions, including "construction completion services"; and 30 31 32 WHEREAS, The City began performing maintenance work on the Seawall earlier this year, but did not complete such services due to lack of funding and uncertainties regarding the 33 formation of the Seawall Armor Rock Special Assessment District; and 34 35 36 WHEREAS, The City Council has since formed the Seawall Armor Rock Special Assessment District and new funding for the proposed maintenance services will be available 37 38 in the Ocean Drive Special Service District; and 39 40 WHEREAS, We need to continue the maintenance work as quickly as possible, so it can be done before the Seawall Revetment Project contractor mobilizes and before the high winter 41 42 storms hit, and

WHEREAS, rather than publicly advertising the maintenance work for two weeks, we expedited the procurement process by faxing requests for bids for completing the labor work to two area contractors experienced providing maintenance services on the existing seawall; and WHEREAS, it is advantageous to undertake this work before the Armor Rock Revetment Contractor mobilizes because (1) it simplifies logistics and (2) the maintenance work is not subject to prevailing wages; and WHEREAS, We received two bids for labor on October 23, 2020, and two bids were received, one from East Road Services in the amount of \$44,736 and Dibble Creek Rock in the amount of \$100,000; and WHEREAS, East Road Services of Homer, Alaska was found to be the lowest responsive and responsible bidder to provide labor; and WHERAS, Dibble Creek Rock is a sole source provider of immediately available shot rock and has 600 cubic yards of the material available; and WHEREAS, the City Council is expected to approve the first reading at their October 26 meeting and the second reading at their November 6 meeting of an ordinance authorizing the expenditure of funds required to complete this project, and WHEREAS, Contract awards are not final until the City of Homer issues written notification to the firm. NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of Homer, Alaska, takes the following actions: a. Authorizes an exemption of the Homer Procurement Code for these maintenance services and substantial compliance. b. Awards the contract for the Homer Seawall Maintenance **Labor** Services to East Road Services, of Homer, Alaska in the amount of \$44,736. c. Awards a sole source contract to Dibble Creek Rock Ltd, for 600 cubic yards of shot rock, in the amount not to exceed \$42,000. d. Authorizes the City Manager to execute the appropriate documents.
