ORDINANCE 21-04

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF HOMER, ALASKA
AMENDING THE FY21 CAPITAL BUDGET AND AUTHORIZING THE
EXPENDITURE OF AN ADDITIONAL \$19,700 FOR THE AIRPORT AND
LIBRARY SECURITY CAMERA REPLACEMENT PROJECT.

WHEREAS, Through Ordinances 18-44(A) and 19-38(A)(S), the Homer City Council has previously allocated funds in the amount of \$60,000 to replace existing security cameras at the Homer Public Library and the Homer Airport; and

WHEREAS, The Review Committee for the Upgrade to Video Security Systems Request for Proposals recommends awarding the contract to the firm of Sherman Technologies, LLC, to supply the security cameras and the necessary supporting equipment, and to complete the installation at both the library and the airport, for a total cost of \$76,100; and

WHEREAS, The design of the replacement system requires an additional 18 perpetual software licenses for the operation of the cameras, at a total cost of \$3,600.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF HOMER ORDAINS:

Section 1. That the FY21 Capital Budget is hereby amended by appropriating an additional \$19,700 for the Airport and Library Security Camera Replacement as follows:

Section 2. This ordinance is a budget amendment only, is not of a permanent nature and is a non-code ordinance.
