Resolutions 96-43 and 96-106 were adopted in support of the establishment of a 16 17 National Estuarine Research Reserve in Kachemak Bay; and 18 WHEREAS, Resolution 98-14 was adopted in strong support of that newly established 19 20 Kachemak Bay National Estuarine Research Reserve (KBNERR); and 21 WHEREAS, The University of Alaska Anchorage (UAA) is now designated by the State of 22 Alaska and in the KBNERR Management Plan, as the agency responsible for managing the 23 24 Reserve; and 25 26 WHEREAS, KBNERR's stated goals are research, monitoring, education, and training, 27 providing a natural field laboratory and a living classroom for improving the scientific understanding and management of national resources in and around Kachemak Bay; and 28 29 30 WHEREAS, Their management plan encourages the free exchange of management, 31 research, and assessment data among agencies; and 32 WHEREAS, KBNERR has historically provided beneficial research services to the City on 33 multiple City projects such as including baseline data on coastal bluff erosion used in project 34 considerations like Seawall improvements and erosion mitigation, groundwater models for 35 Bridge Creek reservoir, work on the City's climate action plan, and providing trainings on green 36 infrastructure, among others; and 37 38 WHEREAS; The addition of UAA as KBNERR's managing partner will serve as a magnet 39 for emerging research and technological approaches to help understand and manage any 40 regional ecological shifts to coastal and marine ecosystems in ways that promote their 41 resilience and sustainability; and 42

WHEREAS, KBNERR has stated that any activities or research conducted within City lands will be conducted in a manner which is consistent with the management plans for the City and those of KBNERR, and that the City shall be fully and regularly consulted by UAA regarding research and education needs, opportunities, and information pertaining to KBNERR; and

WHEREAS, The City of Homer is listed under the KBNERR management plan as a cooperative partner within administrative and educational fields with no financial obligation now or in the future.

 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Homer City Council hereby approves the Memorandum of Understanding between the City of Homer, University of Alaska Anchorage, and Kachemak Bay National Estuarine Research Reserve in support of their goals of research, monitoring, education, and training in and around Kachemak Bay to encourage the study and free exchange of management, research, and assessment data among agencies; and authorizing the city manager to negotiate and execute the appropriate documents.
