RESOLUTION 21-012

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF HOMER, ALASKA
AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO REVIEW AND RELEASE
APPROVED CAPITAL PROJECTS WHICH HAD BEEN PUT ON HOLD
BY RESOLUTION 20-050 ON A CASE-BY-CASE BASIS

WHEREAS, The Mayor of the City of Homer declared a local emergency in response to the COVID-19 pandemic on March 18, 2020 and that emergency declaration has been extended repeatedly due to the ongoing nature of the emergency; and

WHEREAS, The Council approved Resolution 20-050 which directed staff to delay certain non-critical capital projects; and

WHEREAS, City staff evaluated projects and put them on hold throughout the remainder of 2020; and

WHEREAS, Many which were able to wait in 2020 have become more critical to complete in 2021; and

WHEREAS, The City has become more confident in the state of its economic resiliency in relation to the impacts caused by the pandemic; and

WHEREAS, It is imperative to make a determination as soon as possible to allow staff enough time to plan their projects which have limited windows of opportunity regarding weather and other conditions.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Manager is authorized to review and release approved capital projects which had been put on hold by Resolution 20-050 on a case-by-case basis.


