RESOLUTION 21-016

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF HOMER, ALASKA,
AWARDING A TERM CONTRACT FOR PROFESSIONAL SERVICES TO
COBLE GEOPHYSICAL SERVICES; AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY
MANAGER TO NEGOTIATE AND EXECUTE THE APPROPRIATE
DOCUMENTS.

WHEREAS, Public Works maintains nine engineering services term contracts which are awarded through a competitive qualifications-based procedure. This was last accomplished in 2017 and these contracts will expire in 2022; and

WHEREAS, Only three of these contracts are with local firms; and

WHEREAS, The City encourages Departments to use local businesses whenever possible (i.e. – 5% local bidders preference), and

WHEREAS, The Public Works Department is currently working on multiple projects involving groundwater issues; and

WHEREAS, Geoffrey Coble is a geophysicist, which expertise and extensive experience with groundwater mapping, investigations and analysis and operates a professional services consulting firm; and

WHEREAS, All term contracts will expire in 2022 and a new competitive process will be completed; and

WHEREAS, This award is not final until written notification is received by the firm from the City of Homer.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of Homer, Alaska, based on the value of having a term contract with a local firm, possessing expertise and experience with groundwater mapping, investigation and analysis, awards a short-term term contract for engineering services (from February 2021 to April 2022) to Coble Geophysical Services, and authorizes the City Manager to negotiate and execute the appropriate documents.
