1 CITY OF HOMER 2 HOMER, ALASKA 3 City Manager 4 **ORDINANCE 21-25** 5 6 AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF HOMER, ALASKA, 7 AMENDING THE FY21 CAPITAL BUDGET BY ACCEPTING AND APPROPRIATING THE FY21 STATE OF ALASKA COMMUNITY 8 9 ASSISTANCE PROGRAM PAYMENT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$76,842.94 TO THE FIRE CAPITAL ASSET REPAIR AND MAINTENANCE 10 ALLOWANCE (CARMA) FUND AND AUTHORIZING EXPENDITURE OF 11 12 UP TO \$260,000 FROM THE FIRE CARMA FUND TO REPLACE THE FIRE DEPARTMENT'S SELF CONTAINED BREATHING APPARATUS 13 14 SYSTEM. 15 WHEREAS, In FY21 the City of Homer received \$76,842.94 from the Community 16 Assistance Program (CAP) which has not yet been accepted or appropriated; and 17 18 WHEREAS, The application for the FY CAP funds indicated the City of Homer would 19 designate those funds towards City reserves, specifically the Old Middle School (HERC) CARMA 20 account; and 21 22 23 WHEREAS, The State's CAP program allows communities to deviate from their applications as long as the resultant use will be used for a public purpose as required under AS 24 29.60.850(a) and the municipality agrees to make available a service or facility with the funds 25 26 under AS 29.60.855-29.60.879 to every person in the community; and 27 WHEREAS, The current Self Contained Breathing Apparatus (SCBA) system in use by the 28 Volunteer Fire Department is nearing the end of its useful life; and 29 30 31 WHEREAS, Firefighters with use and access of an appropriate SCBA system helps to 32 provide a critical public service to the community; and 33 34 WHEREAS, The City has been unsuccessful in its pursuit of grant funding for this 35 replacement project; and 36 WHEREAS, Administration believes that using the CAP funds to updated safety 37 equipment for the Volunteer Fire Department is a more appropriate use of these funds at this 38 time; and 39 40 WHEREAS, The FY20 budget previously authorized up to \$170,000 for SCBA 41 42 improvements; and

43 WHEREAS, After the transfer of CAP funds to the Fire CARMA account, there will be 44 sufficient funds for this replacement project. 45 46 NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF HOMER ORDAINS: 47 48 Section 1. The Homer City Council hereby accepts and appropriates a 2021 Community 49 Assistance Program payment in the amount of \$76,842.94 to the Fire CARMA fund as follows: 50 51 Revenue: 52 53 54 Account No. Description Amount 151-7012-4520 Community Assistance \$76,842.94 55 56 57 Transfer: 58 Amount 59 Account No. Description 156-0393-5901 Fire CARMA \$76,842.94 60 61 Section 2. The City of Homer's 2021 Capital Budget is hereby amended by appropriating 62 funds of up to \$265,000 from the Fire CARMA Fund to purchase a replacement Self Contained 63 64 Breathing Apparatus (SCBA) System for the Volunteer Fire Department. 65 Account No. Description Amount 66 Fire CARMA \$265,000 156-0393-5901 67 68 Section 3.
