CITY OF HOMER 1 2 HOMER, ALASKA 3 City Manager **RESOLUTION 21-040** 4 5 A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF HOMER, ALASKA, 6 APPROVING NEW ONE-YEAR CONTRACTS WITH PREMERA BLUE 7 CROSS, VSP, AND PRUDENTIAL WITH A RENEWAL DATE OF 8 AUGUST 1, 2021. 9 10 11 12 WHEREAS, Premera Blue Cross extended an initial renewal offer of 25.2% increase to Medical/Rx costs and a 5% increase to Dental costs for the 2021-22 plan year; and 13 14 WHEREAS, USI conducted a targeted market review and solicited bids for healthcare 15 16 from multiple carriers; and 17 18 WHEREAS, Premera Blue Cross submitted a second proposal for Medical/ Rx and Dental, which would move the City to Premera's Political Subdivision plan, but retain the same 19 20 network coverage; and 21 22 WHEREAS, VSP extended a rate pass for Vision, and these rates were offered with a two-23 year rate guarantee, which provides the City with the best rate for those benefits; and 24 25 WHEREAS, Prudential extended a 40% decrease to the Life/ AD&D plan for Life Insurance and a rate pass to the Voluntary Life/ AD&D plan, and these rates were offered with 26 a two-year rate guarantee, which provides the best rate for those benefits; and 27 28 WHEREAS, Renewing the contract with Premera Blue Cross effective August 1st, 2021 29 results in an overall health care increase of 4.3% based on current enrollment and rates, and a 30 9.4% increase over original FY2021 budget; and 31 32 WHEREAS, The Employee Committee reviewed the benefit coverage and cost 33 projections for the August 1st, 2021 renewal, and supports this recommendation. 34 35 36 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Homer City Council hereby approves new one-year contracts based upon the proposals with terms beginning on August 1, 2021, and 37 authorizes the City Manager to execute the appropriate documents. 38 39 PASSED AND ADOPTED by the Homer City Council this 14th day of June, 2021. 40 41
